

Frequently Asked Questions

1. The excel file doesn't open.

You probably have older software and you will need to email the webmaster and request the application in Excel 2003. LHSCweb@dps.la.gov

2. May I submit a hard copy of the application?

No. All applications must be submitted electronically via the web at LHSCweb@dps.la.gov

3. I am a current recipient of an LHSC grant, must I re-apply?

Yes. All current recipients must apply for a FFY 2012 grant.

4. What if I don't have a DUNS or CAGE #

The CAGE # is not mandatory. You may submit your application without a DUNS#; however, if you are awarded a contract, the DUNS is mandatory to receive payment. Please visit the DNB website at

5. I can't enter the Agency Fax #.

This is an application error. Please enter the information of the "Responsible Parties" page.

6. Is "Match" required? If you are applying for alcohol funds or for a Safe Community, 20% match is required.

The 20% is calculated from the portion of your application for alcohol and Safe Communities.

(i.e. Your proposal is \$10,000 for an alcohol program and \$10,000 for a seat belt program. 20% of the alcohol portion is \$2,000. You would be required, at a minimum, to have a \$2,000 match)
